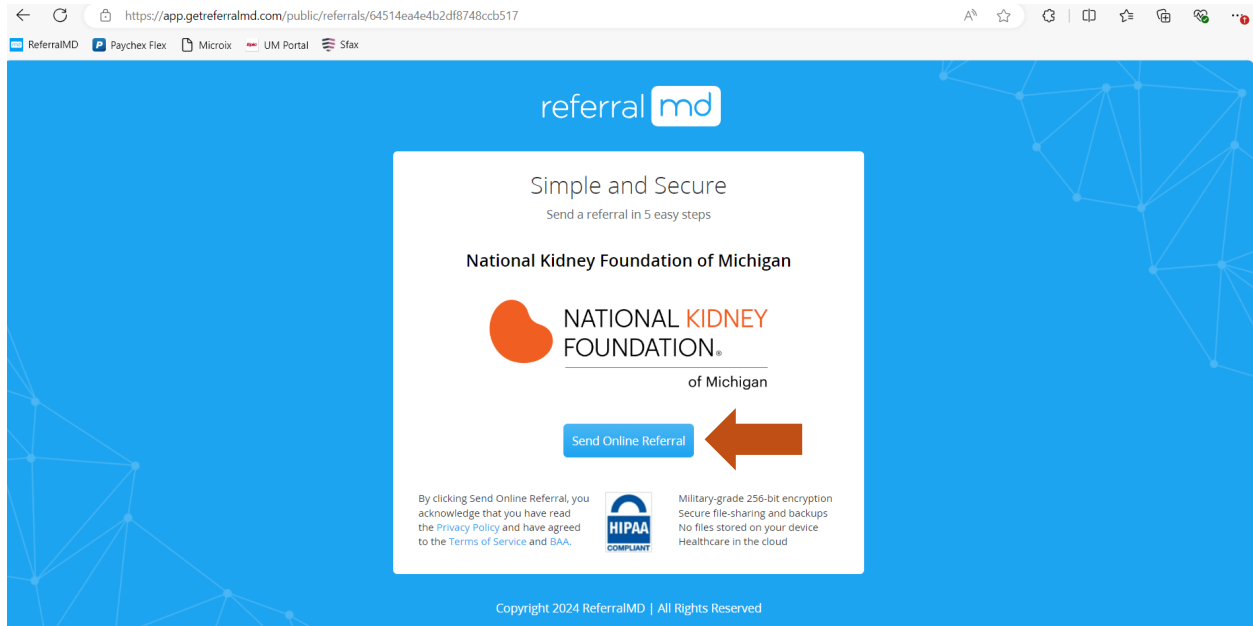

1. Enter the **Patient** details. Click Continue.
